- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter O, Chapter 21,
- 6 Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER O. EDUCATOR EXCELLENCE <u>INNOVATION</u> [AWARDS] PROGRAM
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 21.701, Education Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:

- 10 Sec. 21.701. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "program"
- 11 means the educator excellence innovation [awards] program.
- 12 SECTION 3. Subchapter O, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
- 13 amended by adding Section 21.7011 to read as follows:
- Sec. 21.7011. PURPOSES. The purposes of the educator
- 15 excellence innovation program are to:
- 16 (1) systemically transform:
- 17 (A) educator quality and effectiveness through
- 18 improved and innovative school district-level recruitment,
- 19 preparation, hiring, induction, evaluation, professional
- 20 development, strategic compensation, career pathways, and
- 21 retention; and
- 22 (B) district administrative practices to improve
- 23 quality, effectiveness, and efficiency; and
- 24 (2) use the enhanced educator and administrative

- 1 quality and effectiveness to improve student learning and student
- 2 academic performance, especially the learning and academic
- 3 performance of a district's most educationally disadvantaged or
- 4 educationally underserved students.
- 5 SECTION 4. The heading to Section 21.702, Education Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 21.702. EDUCATOR EXCELLENCE <u>INNOVATION</u> [AWARDS]
- 8 PROGRAM.
- 9 SECTION 5. Sections 21.702(a) and (b), Education Code, are
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The commissioner by rule shall establish the [an
- 12 educator excellence awards] program under which school districts,
- 13 in accordance with local $\underline{\text{educator excellence innovation}}$ [$\underline{\text{awards}}$]
- 14 plans approved by the commissioner, receive competitive program
- 15 grants from the agency for <u>carrying out</u> the <u>purposes of the program</u>
- 16 <u>as described</u> [purpose of providing awards to district employees in
- 17 the manner provided] by Section 21.7011 [21.705].
- 18 (b) In establishing the program, the commissioner shall
- 19 adopt program guidelines in accordance with this subchapter for a
- 20 school district to follow in developing a local educator excellence
- 21 <u>innovation</u> [awards] plan under Section 21.704.
- 22 SECTION 6. Section 21.703, Education Code, is amended to
- 23 read as follows:
- Sec. 21.703. EDUCATOR EXCELLENCE INNOVATION FUND; AMOUNT OF
- 25 GRANT AWARD. $[\frac{(a)}{a}]$ Each state fiscal year, the commissioner shall
- 26 deposit an amount determined by the General Appropriations Act to
- 27 the credit of the educator excellence innovation fund in the

- 1 general revenue fund. Each state fiscal year, the agency shall use
- 2 money [funds] in the educator excellence innovation fund to provide
- 3 a [qualifying] school district approved on a competitive basis
- 4 under this subchapter with a grant in an amount determined by:
- 5 (1) dividing the amount of money available for
- 6 distribution in the educator excellence <u>innovation</u> fund by the
- 7 total number of students in average daily attendance in the
- 8 approved [qualifying] districts for that fiscal year; and
- 9 (2) multiplying the amount determined under
- 10 Subdivision (1) by the number of students in average daily
- 11 attendance in the district.
- 12 SECTION 7. Section 21.704, Education Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 21.704. LOCAL EDUCATOR EXCELLENCE INNOVATION [AWARDS]
- 15 PLANS. (a) A district-level committee for a school district that
- 16 intends to participate in the program, such as the district-level
- 17 planning and decision-making committee established under
- 18 Subchapter F, Chapter 11, shall develop a local educator excellence
- 19 innovation [awards] plan for the district. The local educator
- 20 excellence innovation [awards] plan may provide for all campuses in
- 21 the district to participate in the program or only certain campuses
- 22 selected by the district-level committee. [A majority of classroom
- 23 teachers assigned to a campus that is selected by the
- 24 district-level committee to participate in the program must approve
- 25 participation to be included in the local awards plan.
- 26 (c) A school district must [shall] submit a local educator
- 27 excellence innovation [awards] plan to the agency for approval.

- 1 [The plan must be submitted together with evidence of significant
- 2 teacher involvement in the development of the plan.
- 3 (c-1) A local <u>educator excellence innovation</u> [awards] plan
- 4 must be designed to carry out each purpose of the program as
- 5 described by Section 21.7011 [provide for teachers and principals
- 6 eligible to receive awards under the plan to be notified of the
- 7 specific criteria and any formulas on which the awards will be based
- 8 before the beginning of the period on which the awards will be
- 9 based].
- 10 (d) The agency may approve only a local <u>educator excellence</u>
- 11 innovation [awards] plan that meets program guidelines adopted by
- 12 the commissioner under Section 21.702 and that satisfies this
- 13 section and Section 21.706 [$\frac{21.705}{}$]. From among the local educator
- 14 excellence innovation plans submitted and depending on the amount
- 15 of money available for distribution in the educator excellence
- 16 innovation fund, the agency shall approve plans that most
- 17 comprehensively and innovatively address the purposes of the
- 18 program as described by Section 21.7011.
- 19 (e) [The agency shall make model local awards plans
- 20 available to school districts that wish to participate in the
- 21 program.
- [(f)] A school district whose local educator excellence
- 23 <u>innovation</u> [awards] plan is approved by the agency to receive a
- 24 program grant under this subchapter may renew the plan for three
- 25 consecutive school years without resubmitting the plan to the
- 26 agency for approval. A school district may amend a local educator
- 27 excellence innovation [awards] plan for approval by the agency for

- 1 each school year the district receives a program grant.
- 2 SECTION 8. Subchapter O, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
- 3 amended by adding Sections 21.706 and 21.7061 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 21.706. INNOVATION PLAN PAYMENTS; AUTHORIZED GENERAL
- 5 AND SPECIFIC USES. A school district may use grant funds awarded to
- 6 the district under this subchapter only to carry out purposes of the
- 7 program as described by Section 21.7011, in accordance with the
- 8 district's local educator excellence innovation plan, which may
- 9 include the following specific methods or procedures:
- 10 (1) implementation and administration of a
- 11 high-quality mentoring program for teachers in a teacher's first
- 12 three years of classroom teaching using mentors who meet the
- 13 qualifications prescribed by Section 21.458(b);
- 14 (2) implementation of a teacher evaluation system
- 15 <u>using multiple measures that include:</u>
- 16 (A) the results of classroom observation, which
- 17 may include student comments;
- 18 (B) the degree of student educational growth and
- 19 learning; and
- (C) the results of teacher self-evaluation;
- 21 (3) to the extent permitted under Subchapter C,
- 22 Chapter 25, restructure of the school day or school year to provide
- 23 for embedded and collaborative learning communities for the purpose
- 24 of professional development; and
- 25 <u>(4) establishment of an alternative teacher</u>
- 26 compensation or retention system.
- Sec. 21.7061. IMPLEMENTATION FLEXIBILITY. (a)

- 1 Notwithstanding any other provision of this code and subject to
- 2 Subsection (b), a school district may apply to the commissioner in
- 3 writing in accordance with commissioner rule for a waiver to exempt
- 4 the district or one or more district campuses from all or one or
- 5 more specified provisions of this chapter, including Section
- 6 21.402.
- 7 (b) Before an application is submitted to the commissioner
- 8 under Subsection (a), the application must be approved by a vote of:
- 9 (1) a majority of the members of the school district
- 10 board of trustees; and
- 11 (2) a majority of the teachers and other staff members
- 12 at each campus for which the waiver is sought.
- 13 (c) The commissioner shall grant or deny an application
- 14 under this section based on standards adopted by commissioner rule.
- 15 (d) Neither the board of trustees of a school district nor
- 16 the district superintendent may compel a waiver of rights under
- 17 this section.
- 18 SECTION 9. Section 21.705, Education Code, is repealed.
- 19 SECTION 10. This Act applies beginning with the 2014-2015
- 20 school year.
- 21 SECTION 11. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 22 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 23 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 24 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 25 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
