1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to authorizing the board of regents of The University of  
 1-18 Texas System to acquire certain property in the city of Arlington.  
 1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-20 SECTION 1. The board of regents of The University of Texas  
 1-21 System may acquire by purchase, exchange, gift, or otherwise, for  
 1-22 campus expansion and other university purposes of The University of  
 1-23 Texas at Arlington, all or part of the property in the city of  
 1-24 Arlington, Tarrant County, Texas, that is included within the area  
 1-25 with the boundaries specifically described as follows:  
 1-26 BEGINNING at the corner of E. 3rd Street and South Center  
 1-27 Street;  
 1-28 THENCE South along South Center Street to the intersection of  
 1-29 South Center Street and East Mitchell Street;  
 1-30 THENCE East along East Mitchell Street to the intersection of  
 1-31 East Mitchell Street and South Mesquite Street;  
 1-32 THENCE North along South Mesquite Street to the intersection  
 1-33 of South Mesquite Street and E. 3rd Street;  
 1-34 THENCE West along E. 3rd Street to the beginning intersection  
 1-35 at the corner of E. 3rd Street and South Center Street.  
 1-36 SECTION 2. The title to the property shall be taken in the  
 1-37 name of the board of regents of The University of Texas System and  
 1-38 shall be subject to the control and management of the board in the  
 1-39 manner and to the extent that the property now owned by The  
 1-40 University of Texas System in fee simple is held and controlled.  
 1-41 SECTION 3. This Act does not grant the state or The  
 1-42 University of Texas System the power of eminent domain over the  
 1-43 property.  
 1-44 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-45 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-46 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-47 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-48 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
