- 15 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a state supported living
- 16 [school or state] center may provide nonresidential services to
- 17 support an individual if:
- 18 (1) the individual:
- 19 (A) is receiving services in a program funded by
- 20 the department;
- 21 (B) meets the eligibility criteria for the
- 22 intermediate care facility for persons with <u>intellectual</u>
- 23 disabilities [mental retardation] program; and
- (C) resides in the area in which the state

- 5 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 161, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 161.087 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 161.087. GIFTS AND GRANTS. (a) The department may
- 8 accept gifts and grants of money, personal property, and real
- 9 property from public or private sources to expand and improve the
- 10 <u>human services programs for the aging and disabled available in</u>
- 11 this state.
- 12 (b) The department shall use a gift or grant of money,
- 13 personal property, or real property made for a specific purpose in
- 14 accordance with the purpose expressly prescribed by the donor. The
- 15 department may decline the gift or grant if the department
- 16 determines that it cannot be economically used for that purpose.
- 17 (c) The department shall keep a record of each gift or grant
- 18 in the department's central office in the city of Austin.
- SECTION 3. Sections 22.001(f) and 101.026, Human Resources
- 20 Code, are repealed.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
