H.B. No. 1776

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT relating to the definition of "drought" for the purposes of 2 emergency orders concerning water rights issued by the executive 3 director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 11.053, Water Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to 7 read as follows: 8 During a period of drought or other emergency shortage 9 (a) of water, [as defined by commission rule,] the executive director 10 by order may, in accordance with the priority of water rights 11 12 established by Section 11.027: 13 (1) temporarily suspend the right of any person who 14 holds a water right to use the water; and 15 (2) temporarily adjust the diversions of water by water rights holders. 16 (c) The commission shall adopt rules to implement this 17 section, including rules: 18 defining an [a drought or other] emergency 19 (1) 20 shortage of water for purposes of this section; and 21 (2) specifying the: 22 (A) conditions under which the executive director may issue an order under this section; 23 terms of an order issued under this section, 24 (B)

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including the maximum duration of a temporary suspension or 1 adjustment under this section; and 2 3 (C) procedures for notice of, an opportunity for 4 a hearing on, and the appeal to the commission of an order issued 5 under this section. (c-1) For the purposes of this section, "drought" means a 6 drought classified as "exceptional" or "D4" by the National Drought 7 Mitigation Center in accordance with the center's Drought Severity 8 Classification scheme. 9

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
