8	Sec. 201.1145. STUDY REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE. (a)
9	The Border Trade Advisory Committee shall conduct a study regarding
10	the effects on international trade of wait times at points of entry
11	between the United States and the United Mexican States located in
12	this state.
13	(b) The Border Trade Advisory Committee shall consult with
14	the commission to the extent that the commission may provide useful
15	information, expertise, or resources to further the study. The
16	commission shall assist the committee with the study.
17	(c) The study must include recommendations regarding
18	intergovernmental initiatives to reduce wait times and promote
19	international trade.
20	(d) Not later than October 1, 2014, the Border Trade
21	Advisory Committee shall submit a report to the legislature that
22	includes the results of the study and any associated
23	recommendations.
24	(e) This section expires January 1, 2015.
