- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 253, Local Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 253.014 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 253.014. BROKER AGREEMENTS AND FEES FOR SALE OF REAL
- 8 PROPERTY BY HOME-RULE MUNICIPALITY. (a) In this section, "broker"
- 9 means a person licensed as a broker under Chapter 1101, Occupations
- 10 Code.
- 11 (b) The governing body of a home-rule municipality may
- 12 contract with a broker to sell a tract of real property that is
- 13 owned by the municipality.
- 14 (c) The governing body may pay a fee if a broker produces a
- 15 ready, willing, and able buyer to purchase a tract of real property.
- 16 (d) If a contract is made under Subsection (b) with a broker
- 17 to list the tract of real property for sale for at least 30 days with
- 18 <u>a multiple-listing service</u>, the governing body on or after the 30th
- 19 day after the date the property is listed may sell the tract of real
- 20 property to a ready, willing, and able buyer who is produced by any
- 21 broker using the multiple-listing service and who submits the
- 22 highest cash offer.
- (e) The governing body may sell a tract of real property
- 24 under this section without complying with the public auction

- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
