- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 29.004, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (a) A written report of a full individual and initial
- 10 evaluation of a student for purposes of special education services
- 11 shall be completed not later than:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> the 60th <u>school</u> [calendar] day <u>of the student's</u>
- 13 <u>actual school attendance</u> following the date on which the school
- 14 district, in accordance with 20 U.S.C. Section 1414(a), as amended,
- 15 receives written consent for the evaluation, signed by the
- 16 student's parent or legal guardian; or
- 17 (2) for a prekindergarten student, the 60th school day
- 18 <u>following the date on which the school district receives written</u>
- 19 consent for the evaluation, signed by the student's parent or legal
- 20 guardian.
- 21 (a-1) For purposes of Subsection (a), "school day" does not
- 22 include a day that falls after the last instructional day of the
- 23 spring school term and before the first instructional day of the
- 24 subsequent fall school term. The commissioner by rule may

- 1 determine days during which year-round schools are recessed that,
- 2 consistent with this subsection, are not considered to be school
- 3 days for purposes of this subsection.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 29.004(a), Education Code, as amended by
- 5 this Act, applies to completion of a report of a full individual and
- 6 initial evaluation of a public school student for purposes of
- 7 special education services only as to an initial evaluation
- 8 performed on or after September 1, 2013.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
