A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the events eligible to receive funding through a major

3 events trust fund.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 5A(a)(4) and (5), Chapter 1507 (S.B.

6 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article

7 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), are amended to read as

8 follows:

9 (4) "Event" means a Super Bowl, a National Collegiate

10 Athletic Association Final Four tournament game, the National

11 Basketball Association All-Star Game, the National Hockey League

12 All-Star Game, the Major League Baseball All-Star Game, a National

13 Collegiate Athletic Association Bowl Championship Series game, a

14 World Cup Soccer game, the World Games, a national collegiate

15 championship of an amateur sport sanctioned by the national

16 governing body of the sport that is recognized by the United States

17 Olympic Committee, an Olympic activity, including a Junior or

18 Senior activity, training program, or feeder program sanctioned by

19 the United States Olympic Committee's Community Olympic

20 Development Program, the Breeders' Cup World Championships, a

21 Formula One automobile race, the Academy of Country Music Awards,

22 the National Cutting Horse Association Triple Crown, [or] a

23 national political convention of the Republican National Committee

24 or the Democratic National Committee, or an Ultimate Fighting

- 1 Championship worldwide championship fighting event. The term
- 2 includes any activities related to or associated with an event.
- 3 (5) "Site selection organization" means:
- 4 (A) the National Football League, the National
- 5 Collegiate Athletic Association, the National Basketball
- 6 Association, the National Hockey League, Major League Baseball, the
- 7 Federation Internationale de Football Association (FIFA), the
- 8 International World Games Association, or the United States Olympic
- 9 Committee;
- 10 (B) the national governing body of a sport that
- 11 is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, the National
- 12 Thoroughbred Racing Association, Formula One Management Limited,
- 13 or the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile;
- 14 (C) the Academy of Country Music;
- 15 (D) the National Cutting Horse Association; [or]
- 16 (E) the Republican National Committee or the
- 17 Democratic National Committee; or
- 18 (F) the Ultimate Fighting Championship.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
