1 AN ACT 2 relating to liability for injuring a trespassing sheep or goat. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 143.033, Agriculture Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6 Sec. 143.033. INJURY TO TRESPASSING ANIMAL. If a person 7 whose fence is insufficient under this subchapter maims, wounds, or kills a head of cattle or a horse, mule, jack, [or] jennet, sheep, 8 9 or goat, or procures the maiming, wounding, or killing of one of those animals, by any means, including a gun or a dog, the person is 10 11 liable to the owner of the animal for damages. This section does not authorize a person to maim, wound, or kill any horse, mule, 12 jack, jennet, $\underline{\text{sheep, goat,}}$ or head of cattle of another person. 13 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section 143.033, Agriculture Code, applies only to a person who maims, 15 16 wounds, kills, or procures the maiming, wounding, or killing of a sheep or goat on or after the effective date of this Act. A person 17 who maims, wounds, kills, or procures the maiming, wounding, or 18 killing of a sheep or goat before the effective date of this Act is 19 governed by the law in effect on the date the maiming, wounding, 20 killing, or procurement occurred, and the former law is continued 21 in effect for that purpose. 22
