- 2 relating to liability for injuring a trespassing sheep or goat.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 143.033, Agriculture Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:

- 6 Sec. 143.033. INJURY TO TRESPASSING ANIMAL. If a person
- 7 whose fence is insufficient under this subchapter maims, wounds, or
- 8 kills a head of cattle or a horse, mule, jack, [or] jennet, sheep,
- 9 or goat, or procures the maiming, wounding, or killing of one of
- 10 those animals, by any means, including a gun or a dog, the person is
- 11 liable to the owner of the animal for damages. This section does
- 12 not authorize a person to maim, wound, or kill any horse, mule,
- 13 jack, jennet, sheep, goat, or head of cattle of another person.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 15 143.033, Agriculture Code, applies only to a person who maims,
- 16 wounds, kills, or procures the maiming, wounding, or killing of a
- 17 sheep or goat on or after the effective date of this Act. A person
- 18 who maims, wounds, kills, or procures the maiming, wounding, or
- 19 killing of a sheep or goat before the effective date of this Act is
- 20 governed by the law in effect on the date the maiming, wounding,
- 21 killing, or procurement occurred, and the former law is continued
- 22 in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
