- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 51.803(a-3) and (k), Education Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a-3) Notwithstanding Subsection (a-1), The University of
- 8 Texas at Austin may not offer admission under that subsection for an
- 9 academic year after the 2017-2018 [2015-2016] academic year.
- 10 (k) A general academic teaching institution may not offer
- 11 admission under Subsection (a-1) for an academic year <u>after the</u>
- $12 \quad \underline{2017-2018} \quad \text{academic year} \quad \text{if, on the date of the institution's}$
- 13 general deadline for applications for admission of first-time
- 14 undergraduate students for that academic year:
- 15 (1) a final court order applicable to the institution
- 16 prohibits the institution from considering an applicant's race or
- 17 ethnicity as a factor in the institution's decisions relating to
- 18 first-time undergraduate admissions; or
- 19 (2) the institution's governing board by rule, policy,
- 20 or other manner has provided that an applicant's race or ethnicity
- 21 may not be considered as a factor in the institution's decisions
- 22 relating to first-time undergraduate admissions for that[rexcept
- 23 that this subdivision does not apply to an institution that did not
- 24 consider, on or before June 1, 2009, an applicant's race or

- 1 ethnicity as a factor in its admissions of first-time resident
- 2 undergraduate students for the 2009-2010] academic year.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
