- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 301.006(a), Business Organizations
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided by Section 301.013, $a \in A$
- 8 professional association or foreign professional association may
- 9 provide a professional service in this state only through owners,
- 10 managerial officials, employees, or agents, each of whom:
- 11 (1) is a professional individual; and
- 12 (2) is licensed in this state to provide the same
- 13 professional service provided by the entity.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 301, Business Organizations Code, is
- 15 amended by adding Section 301.013 to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 301.013. EMPLOYMENT OF DOCTOR OF MEDICINE OR
- 17 OSTEOPATHY BY CERTAIN PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATIONS. (a) A
- 18 professional association formed and owned by persons licensed as
- 19 chiropractors by the Texas Board of Chiropractic Examiners may
- 20 employ a person licensed by the Texas Medical Board as a doctor of
- 21 medicine or as a doctor of osteopathy to perform professional
- 22 services that fall within the scope of practice of the
- 23 practitioner.
- 24 (b) If a professional association formed and owned by

- 1 chiropractors employs a doctor of medicine or a doctor of
- 2 osteopathy as described by Subsection (a), the authority of each
- 3 practitioner, both owners and employees, is limited to the
- 4 practitioner's scope of practice, and a practitioner may not
- 5 exercise control over another practitioner's clinical authority
- 6 granted under the practitioner's respective license, either
- 7 through an agreement, bylaw, directive, financial incentive, or
- 8 other arrangement that would assert control over a treatment
- 9 decision made by the practitioner.
- 10 SECTION 3. Chapter 162, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 11 adding Subchapter F to read as follows:
- 12 SUBCHAPTER F. EMPLOYMENT OF PHYSICIANS BY CERTAIN PROFESSIONAL
- 13 ASSOCIATIONS
- 14 Sec. 162.251. PATIENT CARE. A physician employed by a
- 15 professional association formed and owned by chiropractors in
- 16 accordance with Section 301.013, Business Organizations Code,
- 17 shall retain independent medical judgment in providing care to
- 18 patients.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
