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relating to the dissolution of the Parker County Utility District 1-16 No. 1.

1-17 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-19

SECTION 1. The Parker County Utility District No. 1 is 1-20 dissolved. 1-21

SECTION 2. The following laws are repealed:

(1) Chapter 7208, Special District Local Laws Code; and

Section 1.04, Chapter 1273, Acts of the 75th Legislature, Regular Session, 1997.

SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, Government Code.

- The governor, one of the required recipients, has the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on (b) submitted Environmental Quality.
- (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of and the speaker lieutenant governor, representatives within the required time.
