- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.31, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsections (o) and (p) to read as follows:
- 7 (o) A determination that a facility, device, or method is
- 8 used wholly or partly as a facility, device, or method for the
- 9 control of air, water, or land pollution is effective January 1 of
- 10 the year following the year in which the determination becomes
- 11 final or, if the determination is appealed, the appeal is finally
- 12 <u>determined</u>.
- 13 (p) Notwithstanding Section 11.43(c), the executive
- 14 director may require a person allowed an exemption under this
- 15 section in a prior year to file a new permit application or permit
- 16 exemption request under Subsection (c) to confirm the person's
- 17 current qualification for the exemption by delivering a written
- 18 notice that a new application or request is required to the person
- 19 previously allowed the exemption.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by Section 11.31(o), Tax
- 21 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a determination that
- 22 becomes final or the appeal of which is finally determined on or
- 23 after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
