- 10 revenue account to be used by the law enforcement agency or, if the
- 11 vehicle, aircraft, watercraft, or outboard motor was located in a
- 12 county with a population of less than 150,000, by the attorney
- 13 <u>representing the state</u>.
- 14 (f) A law enforcement agency or an attorney representing the
- 15 state may use funds transferred under Subsection (d) to compensate
- 16 property owners whose property was damaged as a result of a pursuit
- 17 involving \underline{a} [the] law enforcement agency, regardless of whether the
- 18 agency would be liable under Chapter 101, Civil Practice and
- 19 Remedies Code.
- 20 (g) Before a law enforcement agency or an attorney
- 21 <u>representing the state</u> may compensate a property owner under
- 22 Subsection (f) using funds transferred to a county under Subsection
- 23 (d), the sheriff, [or attorney representing the
- 24 state must submit the proposed payment for compensation for

- 1 consideration, and the commissioners court shall consider the
- 2 proposed payment for compensation, at the next regularly scheduled
- 3 meeting of the commissioners court.
- 4 (h) In this section, "attorney representing the state"
- 5 means a district attorney, criminal district attorney, or county
- 6 attorney performing the duties of a district attorney.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
