- 12 (2) issued by a life insurance company organized in

- 14 Sec. 1101.202. UNFAIR DISCRIMINATION. In addition to the
- requirements under Section 544.002, a life insurance company may 15
- 16 not refuse to insure or provide coverage to an individual, refuse to
- continue to insure or provide coverage to an individual, limit the 17
- amount, extent, or kind of coverage available for an individual, or 18
- 19 charge an individual a rate that is different from the rate charged
- to other individuals for the same coverage because of the 20
- 21 individual's criminal record.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
