## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of the Texas Transportation Commission to
- 3 alter speed limits.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 545.353(h-2), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (h-2) Notwithstanding Section 545.352(b), [as amended by
- 8 Chapters 663 (H.B. 385) and 739 (H.B. 1075), Acts of the 76th
- 9 Legislature, Regular Session, 1999, the commission shall [may]
- 10 establish a speed limit of [not to exceed] 85 miles per hour on a
- 11 part of the state highway system if:
- 12 (1) that part of the highway system is designed to
- 13 accommodate travel at that established speed or a higher speed; and
- 14 (2) the commission determines, after an engineering
- 15 and traffic investigation, that the established speed limit is
- 16 reasonable and safe for that part of the highway system.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
