A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to professional development training for certain public

- 3 school personnel regarding student disciplinary procedures.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 37.0181 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 37.0181. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT REGARDING
- 8 DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES. (a) Each principal or other appropriate
- 9 <u>administrator who oversees student discipline shall, at least once</u>
- 10 every three school years, attend professional development training
- 11 regarding this subchapter, including training relating to the
- 12 <u>distinction between a discipline management technique used at the</u>
- 13 principal's discretion under Section 37.002(a) and the
- 14 discretionary authority of a teacher to remove a disruptive student
- 15 under Section 37.002(b).
- 16 (b) Professional development training under this section
- 17 may be provided in coordination with regional education service
- 18 centers through the use of distance learning methods, such as
- 19 <u>telecommunications networks</u>, and using available agency resources.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
