The executive commissioner by rule shall 11 12 provide that an individual is eligible for emergency medical services personnel certification through reciprocity if the 13 14 individual: 15 (1) successfully completed emergency medical services training provided by the United States military; 16 (2) has emergency medical services personnel 17 credentials from the United States military; and 18 (3) is certified by the National Registry of Emergency 19 20 Medical Technicians. 21 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2014, the executive 22 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall 23 adopt rules necessary to implement Section 773.050(c-1), Health and

Safety Code, as added by this Act.
