4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2054.158, Government Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 2054.158. QUALITY ASSURANCE TEAM; DUTIES. (a) The
8	state auditor, Legislative Budget Board, and department shall:
9	(1) create a quality assurance team to perform the
10	duties specified in this chapter and other law; and
11	(2) specify in writing the responsibilities of the
12	state auditor, Legislative Budget Board, and department in
13	performing the duties.
14	(b) The quality assurance team shall:
15	(1) develop and recommend policies and procedures to
16	improve state agency information resources technology projects;
17	and
18	(2) develop and recommend procedures to improve the
19	implementation of state agency information resources technology
20	projects by including considerations for best value and return on
21	investment.
22	SECTION 2. Section 2262.101, Government Code, is amended to
23	read as follows:
24	Sec. 2262.101. CREATION; DUTIES. (a) The Contract Advisory

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Team is created to assist state agencies in improving contract
 management practices by:

3 (1) reviewing <u>and making recommendations on</u> the 4 solicitation <u>documents and contract documents for</u> [<del>of major</del>] 5 contracts <u>of</u> [<del>by</del>] state agencies <u>that have a value of at least \$10</u> 6 <u>million;</u>

7 (2) reviewing any findings or recommendations made by
8 the state auditor, including those made under Section 2262.052(b),
9 regarding a state agency's compliance with the contract management
10 guide; [and]

11 (3) providing recommendations to the <u>comptroller</u> 12 [commission] regarding:

13 (A) the development of the contract management 14 guide; and

(B) the training under Section 2262.053;
 (4) developing and recommending policies and
 procedures to improve state agency contract management practices;
 (5) developing and recommending procedures to improve

19 state agency contracting practices by including consideration for 20 <u>best value; and</u>

21 (6) creating and periodically performing a risk
22 assessment to determine the appropriate level of management and
23 oversight of contracts by state agencies.

24 (b) The risk assessment created and reviewed under 25 Subsection (a)(6) must include, but is not limited to the following 26 criteria:

27 (1) the amount of appropriations to the agency;

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1	(2) total contract value as percentage of
2	appropriation to the agency; or
3	(3) the impact of the functions and duties of the state
4	agency on health, safety, and well-being of citizens.
5	(c) The comptroller shall oversee the activities of the
6	team, including ensuring that the team carries out its duties under
7	Subsection (a)(5).
8	(d) A state agency shall:
9	(1) comply with a recommendation made under Subsection
10	(a)(1); or
11	(2) submit a written explanation regarding why the
12	recommendation is not applicable to the contract under review.
13	SECTION 3. Section 2262.102, Government Code, is amended by
14	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read
15	as follows:
16	(a) The team consists of the following $\underline{six}$ [five] members:
17	(1) one member from the <u>Health and Human Services</u>
18	<pre>Commission [attorney general's office];</pre>
19	(2) one member from the comptroller's office;
20	(3) one member from the Department of Information
21	Resources;
22	(4) one member from the Texas <u>Facilities</u> [ <del>Building and</del>
23	Procurement] Commission; [and]
24	(5) one member from the governor's office; and
25	(6) one member from a small state agency.
26	(c) The attorney general's office shall provide legal
27	assistance to the team.

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1(d) In this section, "small state agency" means a state2agency with fewer than 100 employees.

3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
