- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 9.516(b), Business & Commerce Code, as
- 6 effective July 1, 2013, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Filing does not occur with respect to a record that a
- 8 filing office refuses to accept because:
- 9 (1) the record is not communicated by a method or
- 10 medium of communication authorized by the filing office;
- 11 (2) an amount equal to or greater than the applicable
- 12 filing fee is not tendered;
- 13 (3) the filing office is unable to index the record
- 14 because:
- 15 (A) in the case of an initial financing
- 16 statement, the record does not provide a name for the debtor;
- 17 (B) in the case of an amendment or information
- 18 statement, the record:
- 19 (i) does not identify the initial financing
- 20 statement as required by Section 9.512 or 9.518, as applicable; or
- 21 (ii) identifies an initial financing
- 22 statement whose effectiveness has lapsed under Section 9.515;
- (C) in the case of an initial financing statement
- 24 that provides the name of a debtor identified as an individual or an

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- 1 amendment that provides a name of a debtor identified as an
- 2 individual that was not previously provided in the financing
- 3 statement to which the record relates, the record does not identify
- 4 the debtor's surname; or
- 5 (D) in the case of a record filed or recorded in
- 6 the filing office described in Section 9.501(a)(1), the record does
- 7 not provide the name of the debtor and a sufficient description of
- 8 the real property to which it relates;
- 9 (4) in the case of an initial financing statement or an
- 10 amendment that adds a secured party of record, the record does not
- 11 provide a name and mailing address for the secured party of record;
- 12 (5) in the case of an initial financing statement or an
- 13 amendment that provides a name of a debtor that was not previously
- 14 provided in the financing statement to which the amendment relates,
- 15 the record does not:
- 16 (A) provide a mailing address for the debtor; or
- 17 (B) indicate whether the name provided as the
- 18 name of the debtor is the name of an individual or an organization[+
- 19 or
- [(C) if the financing statement indicates that
- 21 the debtor is an organization, provide:
- 22 [(i) a type of organization for the debtor;
- 23 [(ii) a jurisdiction of organization for
- 24 the debtor; or
- 25 [(iii) an organizational identification
- 26 number for the debtor or indicate that the debtor has none];
- 27 (6) in the case of an assignment reflected in an

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- 1 initial financing statement under Section 9.514(a) or an amendment
- 2 filed under Section 9.514(b), the record does not provide a name and
- 3 mailing address for the assignee;
- 4 (7) in the case of a continuation statement, the
- 5 record is not filed within the six-month period prescribed by
- 6 Section 9.515(d); or
- 7 (8) the record is not on an industry standard form,
- 8 including a national standard form or a form approved by the
- 9 International Association of Commercial Administrators, adopted by
- 10 rule by the secretary of state.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 2013, if it
- 12 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 13 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 14 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that
- 15 date, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
