## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to contributions by a corporation or labor organization
- 3 from an employee or member that are used to assist a political
- 4 committee; providing a criminal penalty.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 253, Election Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 253.1015 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 253.1015. SEPARATION OF POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS FROM
- 9 REQUIRED PAYMENT. (a) A corporation or labor organization must
- 10 solicit contributions used to assist a political committee
- 11 separately from dues, fees, or other money required as a condition
- 12 of employment or condition of membership in a labor organization
- 13 and may not accept a contribution unless the employee or labor
- 14 organization member makes a separate election to contribute to the
- 15 political committee.

- 16 (b) An employer shall list any contribution from the
- 17 employee used to assist a political committee deducted from an
- 18 employee's paycheck separately from any other deduction on a
- 19 statement of earnings.
- 20 <u>(c) A person who violates this section commits an offense.</u>
- 21 An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
