## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the effect of rules and standards adopted by the 3 Railroad Commission of Texas relating to the liquefied petroleum 4 gas industry on ordinances, orders, or rules adopted by political 5 subdivisions relating to that industry.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Section 113.054, Natural Resources Code, is 8 amended to read as follows:

Sec. 113.054. EFFECT ON OTHER LAW. The rules and standards 9 promulgated and adopted by the commission under Section 113.051 do 10 not preempt or [and] supersede any ordinance, order, or rule 11 12 adopted by a political subdivision of this state relating to any aspect or phase of the liquefied petroleum gas industry. [A 13 14 political subdivision may petition the commission's executive director for permission to promulgate more restrictive rules and 15 standards only if the political subdivision can prove that the more 16 restrictive rules and standards enhance public safety.] 17

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
