## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to the requirements for the incorporation of a
- 3 municipality in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of certain less
- 4 populous municipalities.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Local Government Code,
- 7 is amended by adding Section 42.0412 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 42.0412. MUNICIPAL INCORPORATION IN EXTRATERRITORIAL
- 9 JURISDICTION OF CERTAIN LESS POPULOUS MUNICIPALITIES. (a) This
- 10 section applies only to an area:
- 11 (1) identified by the federal government as a
- 12 census-designated place;
- 13 (2) included in the extraterritorial jurisdiction, or
- 14 the limited-purpose annexation area, of a home-rule municipality
- 15 with a population of more than 21,000 and less than 46,000 that is
- 16 located in a county with a population of more than 775,000 and less
- 17 <u>than 1.7 million; and</u>
- 18 (3) for which the municipality refused to give its
- 19 consent to incorporation under Section 42.041(a).
- 20 (b) The residents of any part of the area described by
- 21 Subsection (a) may initiate an attempt to incorporate as a
- 22 municipality by filing a written petition signed by at least 10
- 23 percent of the registered voters of the area of the proposed
- 24 municipality with the county judge of the county in which the

- 1 proposed municipality is located. The petition must request the
- 2 county judge to order an election to determine whether the area of
- 3 the proposed municipality will incorporate. An incorporation
- 4 election under this section shall be conducted in the same manner as
- 5 the applicable incorporation election under Subtitle A. The
- 6 consent of the municipality that previously refused to give consent
- 7 is not required for the incorporation.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
