A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the receipt or consideration of a petition requesting  
3 detachment and annexation by the board of trustees of a school  
4 district after adoption of consolidation resolutions.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 13, Education Code, is  
7 amended by adding Section 13.1521 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 13.1521. RECEIPT OR CONSIDERATION OF PETITION  
9 REQUESTING DETACHMENT AND ANNEXATION AFTER ADOPTION OF  
10 CONSOLIDATION RESOLUTIONS. If a resolution in favor of  
11 consolidation has been adopted by the board of trustees of each  
12 school district proposed to be consolidated into a particular  
13 single district, none of those boards of trustees may receive or  
14 consider a petition requesting detachment and annexation under  
15 Subchapter B without the consent of each of the other of those  
16 boards of trustees:

17 (1) before consolidation; or

18 (2) before consolidation is disapproved at an election  
19 under Section 13.153.

20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
