- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 140, Local Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 140.009 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 140.009. CONTRACT FOR COLLECTION OF DEBTS IN CIVIL
- 8 CASES. (a) The governing body of a municipality or the
- 9 commissioners court of a county may contract with a private
- 10 attorney or public or private vendor for the collection of a debt
- 11 owed to the municipality or county relating to a civil case,
- 12 including an unpaid fine, fee, or court cost, if the debt is more
- 13 than 60 days overdue.
- 14 (b) A municipality or county contracting with an attorney or
- 15 a vendor under Subsection (a) may authorize a collection fee of not
- 16 more than 30 percent of the amount of the debt collected. The
- 17 collection fee may be used only to compensate the attorney or vendor
- 18 who collects the debt.
- (c) This section does not apply to the collection of
- 20 <u>commercial bail bonds</u>.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
