REPORT. Not later than January 1 of each 21 even-numbered year[, 2013], the task force shall submit its 22 23 findings and recommendations to: 24 the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of 25 the house of representatives; and (2) the presiding officers of the [Senate Committee on 26
