Sections 1301.002(11) and (12), Occupations 4 5 Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 "Water supply protection specialist" means a person who holds an endorsement issued by the board to engage in: 7 (A) customer service inspections, as defined by 8 rule of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality; and 9 (B) the installation, service, and repair of 10 11 plumbing associated with the treatment, use, and distribution use 12 of rainwater to supply a plumbing fixture $\underline{or}[\tau]$ appliance[τ irrigation system]. 13 (12) "Water treatment" means a business conducted 14 under contract that requires ability, experience, and skill in 15 analyzing water to determine how to treat influent and effluent 16 water to change or purify the water or to add or remove minerals, 17 chemicals, or bacteria. The term does not include treatment of 18 rainwater or the repair of systems for rainwater harvesting. The 19 term includes: 20 21 installing and servicing fixed or portable

water treatment equipment in a public or private water treatment

making connections necessary to install a

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system; or

- 2 SECTION 2. Section 1301.053(a), Occupations Code, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 (a) A person is not required to be licensed under this
- 5 chapter to perform:
- 6 (1) plumbing incidental to and in connection with the
- 7 business in which the person is employed or engaged if the person:
- 8 (A) is regularly employed as or acting as a
- 9 maintenance person or maintenance engineer; and
- 10 (B) does not engage in plumbing for the public;
- 11 (2) construction, installation, or maintenance on the
- 12 premises or equipment of a railroad if the person is an employee of
- 13 the railroad who does not engage in plumbing for the public;
- 14 (3) plumbing if the person is engaged by a public
- 15 service company to:
- 16 (A) lay, maintain, or operate its service mains
- 17 or lines to the point of measurement; and
- 18 (B) install, change, adjust, repair, remove, or
- 19 renovate appurtenances, equipment, or appliances;
- 20 (4) appliance installation and service work, other
- 21 than installation and service work on water heaters, that involves
- 22 connecting appliances to existing openings with a code-approved
- 23 appliance connector if the person performs the work as an appliance
- 24 dealer or an employee of an appliance dealer; or
- 25 (5) water treatment installations, exchanges,
- 26 services, or repairs, other than the treatment of rainwater to
- 27 supply a plumbing fixture or appliance.

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 1301.302, Occupations Code, is amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 1301.302. CONTRACT INFORMATION; REQUIRED DOCUMENTS. A
- 4 written proposal, invoice, or contract relating to plumbing
- 5 services performed by or under the direction of a plumber licensed
- 6 under this chapter must contain the name and license number of the
- 7 responsible master plumber and the name, mailing address, and
- 8 telephone number of the board. The person who performed the
- 9 services shall give the customer an invoice or completed contract
- 10 document on completion of the job, regardless of whether the person
- 11 charged a fee for performing the services.
- 12 SECTION 4. Section 1301.303(a), Occupations Code, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 (a) The board may investigate an alleged violation of this
- 15 chapter by a person who:
- 16 (1) is licensed under this chapter; [or]
- 17 (2) is the owner of a plumbing company subject to this
- 18 chapter; or
- 19 (3) performs plumbing without holding a license under
- 20 this chapter.
- 21 SECTION 5. Section 1301.351, Occupations Code, is amended
- 22 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 23 (d) A person who holds a license or registration issued
- 24 under this chapter shall carry the license or registration on his or
- 25 her person while engaged in plumbing.
- SECTION 6. Section 1301.357(e), Occupations Code, is
- 27 amended to read as follows:

- 1 (e) A person is not required to hold a water supply
- 2 protection specialist endorsement if the person[+
- 3 $\left[\frac{(1)}{1}\right]$ is employed by:
- 4 (1) $\left[\frac{A}{A}\right]$ a political subdivision; or
- 5 (2) [(B)] an electric utility as defined by Section
- 6 31.002, Utilities Code[; and
- 7 [(2) acts as a backflow prevention device specialist
- 8 or water supply protection specialist in the course of the person's
- 9 employment].
- SECTION 7. Sections 1301.551(c) and (g), Occupations Code,
- 11 are amended to read as follows:
- 12 (c) A municipality that adopts an ordinance or bylaw under
- 13 this section shall provide by ordinance or bylaw that a person must
- 14 obtain a permit before the person performs plumbing, other than the
- 15 repairing of leaks, the replacement of lavatory or kitchen faucets,
- 16 the replacement of ballcocks or water control valves, the
- 17 replacement of garbage disposals, or the replacement of water
- 18 closets. The municipality may prescribe the terms on which the
- 19 permit is issued.
- 20 (g) A responsible master plumber, plumbing contractor, or
- 21 other person who is required to obtain a permit under this section
- 22 is not required to pay a plumbing registration fee or
- 23 administrative fee in a municipality or any other political
- 24 subdivision.
- 25 SECTION 8. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 26 services performed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 27 Services performed before the effective date of this Act are

- 1 governed by the law in effect on the date the services were
- 2 performed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 3 purpose.
- SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
