- 6 SECTION 1. Section 602.211(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) On receipt of an application and fee under Section
- 9 602.203, the board may waive any prerequisite for obtaining a
- 10 license to a person who holds a license to practice medical or
- 11 radiological physics in:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> another state, territory, or jurisdiction
- 13 acceptable to the board that has requirements for the licensing of
- 14 medical or radiological physicists that are substantially the same
- 15 as the requirements of this chapter; or
- 16 (2) the United States armed forces, including the
- 17 United States Coast Guard.
- 18 SECTION 2. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 19 Human Services Commission shall adopt rules to implement Section
- 20 602.211(a), Occupations Code, as amended by this Act, as soon as
- 21 practicable after the effective date of this Act.
