2	relating to improving access to nursing education programs.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 51.762, Education Code, is amended by
5	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (g-1) to read as
6	follows:
7	(a) The board, with the assistance of an advisory committee
8	composed of representatives of general academic teaching
9	institutions, junior college districts, public state colleges, and
10	public technical institutes, and with the consultation of all
11	institutions of higher education that admit freshman-level
12	students:
13	(1) shall adopt by rule:
14	(A) a common admission application form for use
15	by a person seeking admission as a freshman student to a general
16	academic teaching institution; [and]

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- 17 (B) an electronic common admission application
- form for use by a person seeking admission as a freshman student to 18
- 19 an institution of higher education that admits freshman-level
- 20 students, other than a general academic teaching institution; and
- 21 (C) an electronic common admission application
- form for use by a person seeking admission to a nursing education 22
- program at an institution of higher education; and 23
- 24 (2) may adopt by rule a printed format common

- 1 admission application form for use by a person seeking admission as
- 2 a freshman student to an institution of higher education that
- 3 admits freshman-level students, other than a general academic
- 4 teaching institution.
- 5 (g-1) The electronic common admission application form for
- 6 use by a person seeking admission to a nursing education program at
- 7 an institution of higher education must include a link to
- 8 information regarding any available scholarship opportunities for
- 9 nursing education degree students at institutions of higher
- 10 education.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 61.026, Education Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- Sec. 61.026. COMMITTEES AND ADVISORY COMMITTEES. (a) The
- 14 chairman may appoint committees from the board's membership as the
- 15 <u>chairman</u> [he] or the board may find necessary from time to time.
- 16 The board may appoint advisory committees from outside its
- 17 membership as it may deem necessary.
- 18 (b) If the board directs an advisory committee to assist the
- 19 board in exercising its authority under Section 61.051(j) regarding
- 20 an off-campus course in nursing education, including clinical
- 21 coursework, the board shall require the advisory committee to
- 22 include or consult with one or more career schools or colleges that
- 23 are authorized to offer degrees in this state and are located in the
- 24 area where the course is to be offered. In this subsection, "career
- 25 school or college" has the meaning assigned by Section 132.001.
- SECTION 3. Section 61.5391(b), Education Code, is amended
- 27 to read as follows:

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- 1 (b) Money in the account may not be appropriated for any
- 2 purpose except:
- 3 <u>(1)</u> to provide loan repayment assistance to eligible
- 4 physicians under this subchapter; or
- 5 (2) to provide loan repayment assistance under
- 6 Subchapter L to eligible faculty of professional nursing programs
- 7 for graduate-level nursing education loans.
- 8 SECTION 4. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 9 shall adopt an electronic common admission application form for
- 10 nursing education programs as required by Section 51.762, Education
- 11 Code, as amended by this Act, not later than September 1, 2014. An
- 12 institution of higher education must accept applications for
- 13 nursing education programs using the electronic common admission
- 14 application form beginning with applicants for admission for the
- 15 2015-2016 academic year.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
