H.B. No. 2100

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to the salary reclassification of certain positions with  
3 the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. (a) The classification officer in the office of  
6 the state auditor shall reclassify the following positions with the  
7 Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas under the Texas  
8 Position Classification Plan, 1961:

9 (1) the positions of Sergeant and Pilot Investigator I shall  
10 be reclassified as salary group C5 positions;

11 (2) the positions of Lieutenant and Pilot Investigator II  
12 shall be reclassified as salary group C6 positions;

13 (3) the positions of Captain and Pilot Investigator III  
14 shall be classified as salary group C7 positions; and

15 (4) the positions of Assistant Commander and Pilot  
16 Investigator IV shall be reclassified as salary group C8 positions.

17 (b) The classification officer in the office of the state  
18 auditor shall replace the position of Trooper in the Department of  
19 Public Safety of the State of Texas with the following new positions  
20 under the Texas Position Classification Plan, 1961:

21 (1) the position of Trooper I classified as a salary group  
22 C3 position; and

23 (2) the positions of Trooper II, III, IV, V, and VI  
24 classified as salary group C4 positions.

1           (c) The classification officer in the office of the state  
2 auditor shall replace the position of Corporal in the Department of  
3 Public Safety of the State of Texas with the following new positions  
4 under the Texas Position Classification Plan, 1961:

5           (1) the position of Corporal I classified as a salary group  
6 C3 position; and

7           (2) the positions of Corporal II, III, IV, V, and VI  
8 classified as salary group C4 positions.

9           SECTION 2. The changes made by the classification officer  
10 as required by Section 1 of this Act apply beginning in the state  
11 fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2013.

12           SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
16 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
