A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 12, Education Code, is amended by adding 6 new Sections 12.141 and 12.142, to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 12.141. DROP OUT PREVENTION AND RECOVERY OPEN
- 8 ENROLLMENT CHARTER HIGH SCHOOLS. (a) To better serve the needs of
- 9 at-risk students, improve the quality of the available workforce,
- 10 and increase student success rates in obtaining and maintaining
- 11 employment, a school that otherwise qualifies as an open enrollment
- 12 charter school may apply in a form approved by the commissioner to
- 13 be assessed as an open enrollment charter high school.
- 14 (b) A compliant application by an open enrollment charter
- 15 school to be assessed as a Drop Out Prevention and Recovery Charter
- 16 High School shall be granted if:
- 17 (1) Fifty percent (50%) or more of its students are 17
- 18 years of age or older; and
- 19 (2) Seventy-five percent (75%) or more of its students
- 20 are considered to be at risk of dropping out of school, as defined
- 21 by Section 29.081.

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- Sec. 12.142. ASSESSMENT AND ACCOUNTABILITY OF DROP OUT
- 23 PREVENTION AND RECOVERY OPEN ENROLLMENT CHARTER HIGH SCHOOLS. (a)
- 24 Provisions of this Title and other laws made applicable to open

- 1 enrollment charter schools by Section 12.104 apply to a Drop Out
- 2 Prevention and Recovery Open Enrollment Charter High School, except
- 3 as follows:
- 4 (1) A student who enrolls at a Drop Out Prevention and
- 5 Recovery Open Enrollment Charter High School shall not be included
- 6 in calculating the drop out or completion rates for the school
- 7 unless the student remains enrolled for at least twenty (20) school
- 8 days.
- 9 (2) Solely for the purpose of assessing the completion
- 10 rate for the students, and measuring the success, of a Drop Out
- 11 Prevention and Recovery Open Enrollment Charter High School in
- 12 educating older students otherwise excluded from the calculation of
- 13 the diploma completion rate under NCES standards, a Drop Out
- 14 Prevention and Recovery Open Enrollment Charter High School may
- 15 request that the commissioner include all students who graduate
- 16 from a Drop Out Prevention and Recovery Open Enrollment Charter
- 17 High School in the calculation of the school's completion rate. The
- 18 calculation methodology under this Section shall be as follows:
- 19 Graduates + GED Recipients + Continuers

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- 21 Graduates + GED Recipients + Continuers + Dropouts
- 22 (3) The commissioner may adopt a set of indicators to
- 23 measure the quality of learning and student achievement at a Drop
- 24 Out Prevention and Recovery Open Enrollment Charter High School.
- 25 (b) A Drop Out Prevention and Recovery Open Enrollment
- 26 Charter High School shall be responsible for reporting the
- 27 information required to perform the assessments described by this

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- 1 Section, performing the calculation specified in Section
- 2 12.142(a)(b), and all reasonable costs incurred by the commission
- 3 <u>in verifying the information and calculation.</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014
- 5 school year.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- $7\,$ a vote of two-thirds of all of the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
