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H.B. No. 2106

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the early voting period for the general primary and 3 general elections for state and county officers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 85.001(a), Election Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (a) The period for early voting by personal appearance 8 begins on the <u>10th</u> [17th] day before election day and continues 9 through the fourth day before election day, except as otherwise 10 provided by this section.

SECTION 2. Sections 85.005(a), (b), and (c), Election Code, are amended to read as follows:

(a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), in an election in which a county clerk or city secretary is the early voting clerk under Section 83.002 or 83.005, early voting by personal appearance at the main early voting polling place shall be conducted on <u>each</u> <u>weekday and Saturday</u> [the weekdays] of the early voting period and during the hours that the county clerk's or city secretary's main business office is regularly open for business.

(b) In an election to which Subsection (a) does not apply, early voting by personal appearance at the main early voting polling place shall be conducted at least eight hours each weekday <u>and Saturday</u> of the early voting period that is not a legal state holiday unless the territory covered by the election has fewer than

1 1,000 registered voters. In that case, the voting shall be 2 conducted at least three hours each day. The authority ordering the 3 election, or the county clerk if that person is the early voting 4 clerk, shall determine which hours the voting is to be conducted.

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5 In a county with a population of 100,000 or more, the (C) voting in a primary election or the general election for state and 6 county officers shall be conducted at the main early voting polling 7 8 place for at least 12 hours on each weekday and Saturday [of the last week] of the early voting period, and the voting in a special 9 10 election ordered by the governor shall be conducted at the main early voting polling place for at least 12 hours on each of the last 11 12 two days of the early voting period. Voting shall be conducted in accordance with this subsection in those elections in a county with 13 14 a population under 100,000 on receipt by the early voting clerk of a 15 written request for the extended hours submitted by at least 50 [15] registered voters of the county. The request must be submitted in 16 17 time to enable compliance with Section 85.067.

18 SECTION 3. Section 85.006, Election Code, is amended to 19 read as follows:

Sec. 85.006. VOTING ON [SATURDAY OR] SUNDAY. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the authority ordering an election may order early voting by personal appearance at the main early voting polling place to be conducted on <u>Sunday</u> [one or more Saturdays or <u>Sundays</u>] during the early voting period.

(b) In an election in which a county clerk or city secretary is the early voting clerk under Section 83.002 or 83.005, only the early voting clerk may order voting on a [Saturday or] Sunday. The

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1 clerk must do so by written order.

2 (c) The authority ordering voting on a [Saturday or] Sunday
3 shall determine the hours during which voting is to be conducted.

4 The authority authorized to order early voting on a (d) 5 [Saturday or] Sunday under Subsection (a) or (b) shall order the voting under the applicable subsection on receipt of a written 6 request submitted by at least 50 [15] registered voters of the 7 territory covered by the election. The request must be submitted in 8 time to enable compliance with Section 85.007. [The authority is 9 10 not required to order the voting on a particular date specified by the request but shall order the voting on at least one Saturday if a 11 12 Saturday is requested and on at least one Sunday if a Sunday is 13 requested.]

14 (e) In a primary election or the general election for state 15 and county officers in a county with a population of 100,000 or more, the early voting clerk shall order personal appearance voting 16 17 at the main early voting polling place to be conducted for at least [12 hours on the last Saturday and for at least] five hours on the 18 [last] Sunday during [of] the early voting period. The early voting 19 clerk shall order voting to be conducted at those times in those 20 elections in a county with a population under 100,000 on receipt of 21 a written request for those hours submitted by at least 50 [15] 22 registered voters of the county. The request must be submitted in 23 24 time to enable compliance with Section 85.007. This subsection supersedes any provision of this subchapter to the extent of any 25 26 conflict.

27 SECTION 4. Sections 85.007(a) and (b), Election Code, are

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1 amended to read as follows:
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(a) The election order and the election notice must state:
(1) the date that early voting will begin if under
Section 85.001(d) the early voting period is to begin later than the
prescribed date;

6 (2) the regular dates and hours that voting will be 7 conducted under Section 85.005(b); and

8 (3) the dates and hours that voting on [Saturday or]
9 Sunday is ordered to be conducted under Section 85.006(a).

10 (b) The early voting clerk shall post notice for each 11 election stating the dates and hours that voting on a [Saturday or] 12 Sunday is ordered to be conducted under Section 85.006(b).

13 SECTION 5. Sections 85.001(b) and (c), Election Code, are 14 repealed.

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SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
