A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the inclusion of food and nutrition instruction in the transitional living services program for certain youth in foster 3 4 care. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 264.121(f), Family Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 The department shall require a person with whom the 8 (f) 9 department contracts for transitional living services for foster youth to provide or assist youth in obtaining: 10 11 (1) housing services; 12 (2) job training and employment services; 13 (3) college preparation services; 14 (4) services that will assist youth in obtaining a general education development certificate; [and] 15 (5) services that will assist youth in developing 16 skills in food preparation; 17 (6) nutrition education that promotes healthy food 18 choices; and 19 20 (7) [(5)] any other appropriate transitional living 21 service identified by the department. SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 22 a person who enters into a contract with the Department of Family 23 and Protective Services to provide transitional living services for 24

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1 foster youth on or after the effective date of this Act.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
