- 13 and supplying the water to, and treating the water for, the proposed

- 17 (5) a draft water right or amendment to a permit,
- 18 certified filing, or certificate of adjudication authorizing the
- 19 <u>transfer</u>.
- 20 (w) The commission shall grant or deny an application for an
- 21 interbasin transfer not later than the 180th day after the date on
- 22 which the commission receives the application. If the commission
- 23 does not grant or deny the application on or before that date, the

- 1 the draft water right or amendment included in the application.
- 2 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 3 an application for an interbasin transfer filed with the Texas
- 4 Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date
- 5 of this Act. An application filed before the effective date of this
- 6 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the application was
- 7 filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
