A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to information about private health care insurance coverage and the health insurance exchange for individuals applying 3 for certain Department of State Health Services programs and 4 5 services. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 1001, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Sections 1001.080 and 1001.081 to read as 8 9 follows: Sec. 1001.080. HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE INFORMATION. (a) 10 In this section, "individual's legally authorized representative" 11 12 means: (1) a parent, managing conservator, or guardian of an 13 individual, if the individual is a minor; 14 15 (2) a guardian of an individual, if the individual has 16 been adjudicated incompetent to manage the individual's personal affairs; or 17 18 (3) an agent of the individual authorized under a 19 durable power of attorney for health care. (b) This section applies to a health or mental health 20 program or service provided by the department or under a department 21 program that the department anticipates will be impacted by a 22 23 health insurance exchange as defined by Section 1001.081(a), 24 including:

(d) The department may waive the prohibition under 23 24 Subsection (c) for an individual or for a mental health program or service described in Subsection (b) if the department determines 25 26 that the program or service is necessary during a crisis or 27 emergency.

(a) 4 In this section: (1) "Health insurance exchange" means an American 5 Health Benefit Exchange administered by the federal government 6 7 under 42 U.S.C. Section 18041 or created under 42 U.S.C. Section 8 18031. 9 (2) "Individual's legally authorized representative" 10 has the meaning assigned by Section 1001.080(a). (b) The department shall develop informational materials 11 12 regarding health care insurance coverage and subsidies available under a health insurance exchange. The informational materials 13 14 must be in English and in Spanish, and to the extent possible, in 15 other languages. 16 (c) The department shall distribute the informational 17 materials developed under Subsection (b) to an individual or the individual's legally authorized representative who: 18 19 (1) applies to receive a health or mental health program or service described in Section 1001.080(b); and 20 21 (2) has an income above 100 percent of the federal poverty level. 22 (d) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary 23 24 to implement this section. 25 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date 26 of this Act, the Department of State Health Services shall

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prescribe the form required by Section 1001.080, Health and Safety

1 Code, as added by this Act.

2 SECTION 3. Not later than June 1, 2014, the Department of 3 State Health Services shall make available the informational 4 materials required by Section 1001.081, Health and Safety Code, as 5 added by this Act.

6 SECTION 4. As soon as possible after the effective date of 7 this Act, the Health and Human Services Commission shall apply for 8 any waiver or other authorization necessary to implement this Act. 9 The commission may delay implementing this Act until the waiver or 10 authorization is granted.

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
