## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the manner in which school districts are ranked for

- 3 purposes of the instructional facilities allotment.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 46.006, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (c-1) and (c-2) and amending Subsection (d) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (c-1) A district's wealth per student is reduced by 15
- 9 percent for purposes of this section if the district demonstrates
- 10 to the commissioner's satisfaction that the district will use
- 11 cost-effective construction and design practices in furtherance of
- 12 the project for which the district seeks assistance. The reduction
- 13 is in addition to any reduction under Subsection (a), (b), or (c)
- 14 and is computed before the district's wealth per student is reduced
- 15 under those subsections, if applicable.
- 16 (c-2) A district's wealth per student is reduced by 15
- 17 percent for purposes of this section if the district has entered
- 18 <u>into a dual-use facility arrangement with a junior college or other</u>
- 19 institution of higher education, as defined by Section 61.003,
- 20 regardless of whether the arrangement involves the project for
- 21 which the district seeks assistance. The reduction is in addition
- 22 to any reduction under Subsection (a), (b), (c), or (c-1) and is
- 23 computed before the district's wealth per student is reduced under
- 24 those subsections, if applicable.

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- 1 (d) The commissioner shall adjust the rankings after making
- 2 the reductions in wealth per student required by Subsections (a),
- 3 (b), [and] (c), (c-1), and (c-2).
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
