- 4 SECTION 1. Section 43.103(3), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (3) "Exotic animals" includes exotic livestock and
- 7 exotic fowl as defined by Section 161.001(a), Agriculture Code,
- 8 wild animals that are nonindigenous to Texas, and aoudad sheep[7
- 9 $\frac{\text{and elk}}{\text{and elk}}$].
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 62.015(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (a) In this section, "exotic animal" means exotic livestock
- 13 or exotic fowl as defined by Section 161.001(a), Agriculture Code,
- 14 and aoudad sheep [-, or elk].
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 67.0011, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 67.0011. EXEMPTIONS [EXEMPTION OF CRAYFISH]. This
- 18 chapter does not apply to $\underline{\cdot}$
- 19 (1) crayfish, other than in public water; or
- 20 (2) elk.
- 21 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 22 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 23 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is covered
- 24 by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former

- 1 law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this
- 2 section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this
- 3 Act if any element of the offense was committed before that date.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
