- 4 SECTION 1. Section 43.103(3), Parks and Wildlife Code, is

- 10 SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 43, Parks and Wildlife
- 11 Code, is amended by adding Section 43.1031 to read as follows:
- Sec. 43.1031. CLASSIFICATION OF ELK. Notwithstanding the
- 13 <u>definition provided by Section 43.103(3)</u>, the commission by rule
- 14 may make a determination that elk are wild animals subject to the
- 15 provisions of this subchapter that apply to exotic animals.
- SECTION 3. Section 62.015(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) In this section, "exotic animal" means exotic livestock
- 19 or exotic fowl as defined by Section 161.001(a), Agriculture Code,
- 20 and aoudad sheep $[\tau \text{ or elk}]$.
- 21 SECTION 4. Subchapter A, Chapter 62, Parks and Wildlife
- 22 Code, is amended by adding Section 62.0151 to read as follows:

- 1 may make a determination that elk are wild animals subject to the
- 2 provisions of this chapter that apply to exotic animals.
- 3 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 4 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 5 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is covered
- 6 by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former
- 7 law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this
- 8 section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this
- 9 Act if any element of the offense was committed before that date.
- 10 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
