- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 202, Agriculture Code, is repealed.
- 5 SECTION 2. (a) The State Soil and Water Conservation Board
- 6 shall proceed with the dissolution of each wind erosion
- 7 conservation district in this state as soon as possible.
- 8 (b) The board shall conduct an inventory of the assets of
- 9 each wind erosion conservation district and determine the debt owed
- 10 by each district.
- 11 (c) The board shall control and administer the property,
- 12 funds, and other assets and the debts of each wind erosion
- 13 conservation district until all assets have been disposed of and
- 14 all debts, including outstanding bonds, of each district have been
- 15 paid or settled.
- 16 (d) After the board has paid all debts and has disposed of
- 17 all assets of a wind erosion conservation district as prescribed by
- 18 this section, the board shall:
- 19 (1) transfer to the county where the district is
- 20 located all net proceeds of the disposal of the assets; and
- 21 (2) file a written report with the commissioners court
- 22 of the county setting forth a summary of the board's actions in
- 23 dissolving the district.
- (e) Not later than the 10th day after the date the

- 1 commissioners court receives the report under Subsection (d)(2) of
- 2 this section and determines that the requirements of this section
- 3 have been fulfilled, the commissioners court shall enter an order
- 4 dissolving the district.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
