- 18 Sec. 49.002. AGE OF ELIGIBILITY. Subject to other
- eligibility criteria specified by rules adopted by the executive 19
- commissioner, a woman is eligible for benefits under the Texas 20
- 21 women's health program if the woman is 15 years of age or older.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
