A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to the investigation of firefighters in certain

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 143.123, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (e-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (e) A person may not be assigned to conduct an investigation
- 9 if the person is the complainant, the ultimate decisionmaker
- 10 regarding disciplinary action, or a person who has any personal
- 11 involvement regarding the alleged misconduct. A fire fighter or
- 12 police officer who is the subject of an investigation has the right
- 13 to inquire and, on inquiry, to be informed of the identities of each
- 14 investigator participating in an interrogation of the fire fighter
- 15 or police officer. Not later than the 30th day after the date that a
- 16 complaint is received by the entity designated by the
- 17 <u>municipality's fire department to receive and investigate</u>
- 18 <u>complaints against a fire fighter</u> [an investigator], [the
- 19 investigator must inform] the fire fighter must be notified in
- 20 writing of the nature of the investigation and the name of each
- 21 person who complained about the fire fighter, if known, concerning
- 22 the matters under investigation unless:
- 23 (1) a criminal investigation has been initiated as a
- 24 result of the complaint; or

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- 1 (2) the disclosure of information concerning the name
- 2 of the complainant or the matters under investigation would hinder
- 3 a criminal investigation.
- 4 (e-1) Notice under Subsection (e) may be provided by
- 5 delivering the notice in person to the fire fighter or by sending
- 6 the notice, certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to
- 7 the fire fighter at the last residence address shown by the records
- 8 of the municipality.
- 9 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 10 a complaint filed on or after September 1, 2013. A complaint filed
- 11 before September 1, 2013, is governed by the law in effect when the
- 12 complaint was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 13 that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
