A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the investigation of firefighters in certain 3 municipalities.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 143.123(e), Local Government Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

7 (e) A person may not be assigned to conduct an investigation if the person is the complainant, the ultimate decisionmaker 8 9 regarding disciplinary action, or a person who has any personal involvement regarding the alleged misconduct. A fire fighter or 10 11 police officer who is the subject of an investigation has the right 12 to inquire and, on inquiry, to be informed of the identities of each investigator participating in an interrogation of the fire fighter 13 14 or police officer. Not later than the 30th day after the date that a complaint is received by the municipality [an investigator], the 15 investigator assigned must inform the fire fighter in writing of 16 the nature of the investigation and the name of each person who 17 complained about the fire fighter, if known, concerning the matters 18 under investigation unless: 19

20 (1) a criminal investigation has been initiated as a21 result of the complaint; or

(2) the disclosure of information concerning the name
of the complainant or the matters under investigation would hinder
a criminal investigation.

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1 SECTION 2. Section 143.123(e), Local Government Code, as 2 amended by this Act, applies only to a complaint filed on or after 3 September 1, 2013. A complaint filed before September 1, 2013, is 4 governed by the law in effect when the complaint was filed, and the 5 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
