## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 28.00222 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 28.00222. INCREASE IN CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION
- 8 COURSES. (a) Not later than September 1, 2014, the State Board of
- 9 Education shall ensure that at least six advanced career and
- 10 technology education courses are approved to satisfy a fourth
- 11 credit in mathematics required for high school graduation.
- 12 (b) Not later than January 1, 2015, the commissioner shall
- 13 review and report to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the
- 14 speaker of the house of representatives, and the presiding officer
- 15 of each standing committee of the legislature with primary
- 16 responsibility over public primary and secondary education
- 17 regarding the progress of increasing the number of courses approved
- 18 for the career and technology education curriculum. The
- 19 commissioner shall include in the report a detailed description of
- 20 any new courses, including instructional materials and required
- 21 equipment, if any.
- 22 (c) This section expires September 1, 2015.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
