## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of the Texas Transportation Commission to

- 3 establish variable speed limits.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 545.353, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsection (k) to read as follows:
- 7 (k) The commission by rule may establish a variable speed
- 8 limit program to allow the temporary lowering of a prima facie speed
- 9 limit to address inclement weather, congestion, road construction,
- 10 or any other condition that affects the safe and orderly movement of
- 11 traffic on a roadway for which the commission has the authority to
- 12 <u>establish a speed limit. Notice of a speed limit established under</u>
- 13 the program may be displayed using a stationary or portable
- 14 changeable message sign, as defined by Section 544.013. A speed
- 15 limit that is established under the program:
- 16 (1) must be based on an engineering and traffic
- 17 investigation;
- 18 (2) may be effective for all or a designated portion of
- 19 the highway and may be effective for any period of the day or night,
- 20 <u>as the department determines necessary; and</u>
- 21 (3) is effective only when the speed limit is posted
- 22 and only if a sign notifying motorists of the change in speed limit
- 23 is posted not less than 500 feet but not more than 1,000 feet before
- 24 the point at which the speed limit begins.
