7	department shall make publicly available on its website information
8	regarding persons licensed under this subchapter including:
9	(1) the current status of a license and the date a
10	license or renewal license was issued, suspended, revoked, or
11	denied;
12	(2) a license holder's business contact information,
13	including telephone number, mailing and physical address, and
14	website, if any;
15	(3) the business contact information for any affiliate
16	of the license holder; and
17	(4) the nature, status, and resolution of any
18	complaint filed against a license holder.

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TRANSFER. (a) A person may not sell, exchange, or lease-purchase or

negotiate for the sale, exchange, or lease-purchase of a used

manufactured home unless the person posts on the door of the home
