(b) If a county is required to make a report available on the 15 16 county's Internet website under Subsection (a), the county shall make the report available for free and may not require a person to 17 register with the county to view the report. 18 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 159, Local Government 19 Code, is amended by adding Section 159.0061 to read as follows: 20 21 Sec. 159.0061. 8 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 159, Local Government 9 Code, is amended by adding Section 159.0342 to read as follows:

10 <u>Sec. 159.0342. AVAILABILITY OF STATEMENTS OF JUSTICES OF</u> 11 <u>THE PEACE ON INTERNET. (a) If a county maintains an Internet</u> 12 <u>website, the county shall make available to the public on the</u> 13 <u>county's Internet website any financial statement filed under this</u> 14 <u>subchapter with the county clerk by a justice of the peace or a</u> 15 <u>candidate for the office of justice of the peace.</u>

16 (b) If a county is required to make a report available on the 17 county's Internet website under Subsection (a), the county shall 18 make the report available for free and may not require a person to 19 register with the county to view the report.

20 SECTION 4. (a) Section 254.04012, Election Code, as added 21 by this Act, applies only to a report required to be filed under 22 Chapter 254, Election Code, that is due on or after January 1, 2014.

(b) The changes in law made by this Act to Chapter 159, Local Government Code, apply only to a financial statement or report required to be filed under that chapter that is due on or after January 1, 2014.
