- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 207.021(a), Labor Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Chapter 215, an unemployed
- 9 individual is eligible to receive benefits for a benefit period if
- 10 the individual:
- 11 (1) has registered for work at an employment office
- 12 and has continued to report to the employment office as required by
- 13 rules adopted by the commission;
- 14 (2) has made a claim for benefits under Section
- 15 208.001;
- 16 (3) is able to work;
- 17 (4) is available for <u>and actively seeking</u> work;
- 18 (5) for the individual's base period, has benefit wage
- 19 credits:
- 20 (A) in at least two calendar quarters; and
- 21 (B) in an amount not less than 37 times the
- 22 individual's benefit amount;
- 23 (6) after the beginning date of the individual's most
- 24 recent prior benefit year, if applicable, earned wages in an amount

- 1 equal to not less than six times the individual's benefit amount;
- 2 (7) has been totally or partially unemployed for a
- 3 waiting period of at least seven consecutive days; and
- 4 (8) participates in reemployment services, such as a
- 5 job search assistance service, if the individual has been
- 6 determined, according to a profiling system established by the
- 7 commission, to be likely to exhaust eligibility for regular
- 8 benefits and to need those services to obtain new employment,
- 9 unless:
- 10 (A) the individual has completed participation
- 11 in such a service; or
- 12 (B) there is reasonable cause, as determined by
- 13 the commission, for the individual's failure to participate in
- 14 those services.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
