- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 15.004, Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 15.004. REPLACEMENT CERTIFICATE. (a) A voter whose
- 8 registration certificate is lost or destroyed may obtain a
- 9 replacement certificate by:
- 10 <u>(1)</u> delivering a written <u>or electronic</u>[, signed]
- 11 notice of the loss or destruction to the registrar; or
- 12 (2) telephoning the registrar to request a
- 13 <u>replacement</u>.
- 14 (b) A replacement certificate requested electronically
- 15 under Subsection (a)(1) or by telephone under Subsection (a)(2) may
- 16 be sent only to the mailing address on the voter's registration
- 17 records.
- (c) Subject to Subsection (b), not [Not] later than the 30th
- 19 day after the date the registrar receives the notice or request, the
- 20 registrar shall deliver to the voter a replacement certificate
- 21 containing:
- 22 (1) the registration number and other information on
- 23 the lost or destroyed certificate; and
- 24 (2) a notation that the certificate is a replacement.

(d) $[\frac{(c)}{(c)}]$ The registrar shall retain <u>a written or electronic</u> 1 [the] notice submitted under Subsection (a)(1) on file with the 2 voter's registration application. <u>If the voter requests a</u> 3 4 replacement registration certificate by telephone under Subsection (a)(2), the registrar shall make a written record of the request and 5 6 keep the record on file with the voter's registration application. 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2013. 11
