6	SECTION 1. Section 7.067, Water Code, is amended by adding
7	Subsection (c) to read as follows:
8	(c) The commission may allow a local government or an
9	organization exempt from federal income taxation under Section
10	501(a), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as an organization described
11	by Section 501(c)(3) of that code, that receives money from a
12	respondent to implement a supplemental environmental project under
13	this section to use a portion of the money, not to exceed 10 percent
14	of the direct cost of the project, for administrative costs,
15	including overhead costs, personnel salary and fringe benefits, and
16	travel and per diem expenses, associated with implementing the
17	project. Money used for administrative costs under this subsection
18	must be used in accordance with Chapter 783, Government Code.
19	SECTION 2. Section 7.067(c), Water Code, as added by this

Act, applies to money received to implement a supplemental environmental project under Section 7.067, Water Code, regardless of whether the money was received on, before, or after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
